### 25/21 Apologies and introductions

### 25/22 Minutes of the meeting held on 16th July 2025 (NM)

## 25/24 UK Biodiversity Indicator on Plant Genetic Resources (LH)

LH shared progress on the development of the UK Plant Genetic Resources Biodiversity Indicator (UKPGRBI) proposal but highlighted that more development is required before the proposal discussion amongst this group will take place. The proposal discussion will take place by the next UKPGRG meeting in March 2026 and will inform the UKPGRBI proposal that this group will submit to JNCC.

Since the last UKPGRG meeting, LH, NM, CW and Joe Taylor met to discuss the UKPGRBI and data collection. One element of outstanding development for the proposed UKPGRBI is obtaining extensive data on plant genetic resources that represents biodiversity across the UK, including sourcing representative data from Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. LH confirmed that data received by IBERS for submission to EURISCO is a subset of available data rather than a source for representative data. For example, EURISCO does not list material that does not have seeds available for request.

A UK national plant genetic resources inventory was highlighted as a necessary database for information sharing. A query was raised regarding whether the current systems that are used to process data for EURISCO submissions have a field that records the availability of accessions. It was confirmed that there is a field for available wild species but not for in-situ species. A key problem with data on EURISCO recording the availability of accessions was noted - the data is not live since UK submissions to EURISCO are made on an annual basis.

The group discussed the aim of the proposed UKPGRBI. It was noted that more data sources may not be helpful if the key questions that the indicator is expected to answer have not yet been determined. A proposal discussion point was raised: whether the scope of the UKPGRBI is biodiversity of plant genetic resources for food and agriculture. It was noted that data from Plant Heritage has wider coverage than food and agriculture.

NM confirmed that he will work with LH to produce discussion points for the development of the UKPGRBI proposal, and these points will be shared with group ahead of the next UKPGRG meeting in March 2026.

**ACTION:** NM and LH to produce UKPGRBI proposal discussion points and circulate amongst the group ahead of the next UKPGRG meeting in March 2026.

#### **25/25 Defra Update (CW)**

CW presented slides to discuss the enhancement of the multilateral system for access and benefit sharing under the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture ahead of the 11<sup>th</sup> Governing Body meeting in Peru from 24-29 November 2025. The group provided feedback on three topics: (i) the expansion of Annex I; (ii) Digital Sequence Information/Genetic Sequence Data (DSI/GSD); (iii) payment structures and rates. CW invited further feedback by email by 31 October 2025.

#### **25/26 Crop wild relative and landraces inventories presentation (HRL and GC)**

There was insufficient time for HRL and GC to present.
